Arthur Naftalin

from Dean J. Brian Atwood

I would like to invite the Humphrey Community to join me in recognizing the passing of long time DFL politician and former Humphrey Institute professor Arthur Naftalin. He died recently at the age of 87.

Naftalin is well known for his political enthusiasm and service to Minneapolis and to the state of Minnesota. He served as mayor of Minneapolis from 1961 to 1969 and was a political contemporary and friend of former Vice President Hubert Humphrey. Naftalin was a former staffer of Humphrey during the early 1940s and is considered an important part of his early career.

We were fortunate enough to welcome Naftalin to the Humphrey Institute faculty during the 1980s as a professor of public affairs and planning. He retired in 1986. In his honor, the Arthur Naftalin Award is given each year to a Humphrey student who has demonstrated exemplary service to his or her community in the past year.

He was a strong political leader during the 1960s and a political scholar and DFL Party pioneer. He is considered a voice that shaped the DFL party of Minnesota throughout the second half of the 20th century.
