#### OVERVIEW OF THE COLLECTION

- Abstract:** Files on the Vice President's trips, mainly to locales outside of Washington, D.C. The majority are within the United States, although several foreign trips are also included.

#### SCOPE AND CONTENTS OF THE FILES

Files on the Vice President's trips, mainly to locales outside of Washington, D.C. The majority are to destinations within the United States; several major foreign trips are also included. These files are an amalgam of several duplicative or closely related sets kept by several staff members.

The files include schedules, programs, briefing materials concerning issues of local or current interest, background information about the area and local officials, the advance staff's information sheets and memoranda, local arrangements documentation, media advisories, press releases, lists of members of the trip group, sometimes talking points or texts of the Vice President's speeches or remarks, trip evaluations, and logistical and follow-up correspondence. In some instances, where duplicate briefing materials were used for several appearances or trips within a narrow time span, a single set was retained and filed at the beginning of the sequence of appearances, with a list of the files in which it was found.

More extensive briefing books, event scenarios, protocol and security arrangements, and the like are present for foreign trips. Foreign trips TR 2-140, TR 2-145, TR 2-197, and TR 2-208 also include separate folders containing the files of advance director Dick Schmitt.

A few files are missing. Most (but not all) of the missing files are or appear to be for domestic or foreign policy conferences with the President, other U.S. government officials, and the presidents of Egypt and Israel. It is likely that these files remain in the custody of the Office of Presidential Libraries, which holds the Vice Presidential Office's foreign affairs files.

## **ARRANGEMENT OF THE COLLECTION**

These files are arranged chronologically by date of trip, with many individual trips also being assigned an individual sequential Central Office file number.

## **RELATED MATERIALS**

A full set of Mondale's speeches is cataloged separately as Speech Text Files. The majority of the files for the Vice President's trips abroad are included among his Foreign Affairs Files, which remain in the custody of the U.S. Office of Presidential Libraries.

## **FINDING AIDS**

A box list gives the shelf locations of the files. It is followed by a file list, which itemizes trip date(s), destination(s), sometimes occasion(s), and folders of supplemental materials.

Note to users: The core of these files was originally the Central Trip files, which were assigned sequential trip numbers by the Vice Presidential office and were intended to constitute the office's master file on the Vice President's trips. In fact, these files consisted primarily of briefing materials, schedules and related items, some texts of speeches and remarks, and follow-up correspondence. They have been augmented by the integration of parallel sets of trip files kept by the VP press office and by Dick Schmitt, Deborah Sale, William F. Roberts, Beckie McGowan and Paul Sheehan of the VP advance office, as well as by trip-related miscellany kept by other staff members.

Provenance: Originally Central Files boxes 1147-1162; Press trip files (boxes 840-844); Advance Office trip files (boxes 700-726, 743); Advance (general) files boxes 780, 784-785, 790-792, and parts of 788-789 and 793; and Transition Office trip files (box 5644).
