### **Topic: Migrant Workers**

*Summary: As Mr. Mondale entered the Senate in 1964, the United States was just ending its experience with the Braceros program, which transported very low wage Mexican agricultural workers to Southern farms. Immigration and the mistreatment of migrant workers became a significant topic in the late 1960s and Mr. Mondale participated in national discussions about it.*
