OVERVIEW OF THE COLLECTION

- Creator:** Mondale, Walter F., 1928-
- Title:** Senatorial case files,
- Dates:** 1964-1976.
- Abstract:** A sampled set of files on constituent issues, mainly problems with Federal government agencies, and the Mondale staff's assistance.
- Quantity:** 17.0 cu. ft. (17 boxes).

SCOPE AND CONTENTS OF THE FILES

A sampled set of files on constituents' difficulties, mostly with the Federal government, and the Mondale staff's assistance. They include incoming letters, copies of outgoing responses, referrals to agencies, and notations of telephone conversations. Many of the earlier cases were originally handled by Hubert H. Humphrey's office, and passed on to Mondale when Humphrey became Vice-President.

A sample of the files from each category was retained. In general, they consist of a complete set of files for the year 1966, by which time the Mondale office staff and procedures were firmly in place, and for the year 1975, near the end of his Senatorial service but before the election year 1976, which may have altered the pattern of staff responses to casework. Modifications to this system were made when the sample years were not represented or when two or more years had been combined into one alphabetical run.

ARRANGEMENT

Divided into seven sections: Immigration and Naturalization, Institutions (prisoners and parolees cases), Miscellaneous Assists, Service and Veterans, Social Security, Employment, and Minnesota Office Cases. Within these groupings the files are arranged by year, and thereunder alphabetically by constituent's name.
