SCOPE AND CONTENTS OF THE FILES

Files primarily concerning applications, nominations, and appointments of postmasters and rural route mail carriers, as well as some letters concerning post office closings and occasional correspondence regarding improvements to post offices and other aspects of mail service and delivery. These files contain incoming letters, copies of outgoing letters, and referrals to post office officials, to the Senate Committee on Post Office and Civil Service (which approved appointments), and to other relevant government agencies. Copies of letters from the offices of Hubert Humphrey and Eugene McCarthy are included in these files.

These files constitute a sampling of the original post office casework files. For 1966, files pertaining to communities beginning with the letters A, J, and S were retained. For 1967-1968, every tenth folder from the original files was retained.
